HIGH SCHOOL DIVISION

Alberta – Boys and Girls Cutting, Saddle Bronc
British Columbia – Tie Down Roping, Breakaway Roping, Team Roping
Manitoba – Barrel Racing, Pole Bending, Goat Tying
Saskatchewan – Bull riding, Steer Wrestling, Bareback riding

JR. HIGH DIVISION

British Columbia – Ribbon Roping, Tie Down Roping, Breakaway Roping
Manitoba – Barrel Racing, Pole Bending, Goat Tying
Saskatchewan – Team Roping, Chute Dogging, Jr. Bull Riding

IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER

- June 24/10** all entries must be received by the CHSRF Secretary and paid in full
- July 1/10** each province will have been notified of rollups to fill each events
- August 1/10** all trades and rollups for illness and injury will close at 6:00p.m.
Must be received by CHSRF Secretary (can be emailed or faxed) but can be paid at registration
- August 4/10** registration of contestants 10 am – 5 pm

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Security will be available for the grounds and the barns August 4 – 6 from midnight until 6 am

All horses must be stalled, NO PORTABLE PENNING will be allowed, NO TYING TO TRAILERS

ALL TIMES ARE DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME. (Ex. Manitoba is 1 hour ahead of Saskatchewan and Alberta and 2 hours ahead of British Columbia)
